Audun recently visited **Waorani Indigenous people** in the Amazon region of Ecuador, on the river now dividing them from group members who have opted to live in voluntary isolation. He will give an illustrated talk with unique photographs of day-to-day life among this recently contacted people, whose territory is threatened by oil extraction and logging.
